ANGEL 7 INDUSTRIES, LLC. DEVELOPS NEW MANUFACTURING PROCESS FOR PHOTOCHROMATIC EYEWEAR AND EYE PROTECTION SYSTEMS

(San Antonio, Texas, August, 2014) - - Angel 7 Industries, LLC, ("A7"), announced today that is has developed a new manufacturing process for photochromatic eye-wear and eye protection systems. A7's proprietary methodology allows photochromatic material to be directly incorporated into various grades of polycarbonate at the manufacturing level and, unlike the currently used "flow-coating method", the new method eliminates multiple steps in the production process. This new method of manufacturing increases production rate, production yield, enhances quality, and reduces the overall cost of photochromatic eye-wear while, at the same time, eliminating manual, secondary steps that normally result in a much lower yield rate with regards to a "flow-coating" process.

"Our new methodology is, basically, the next generation of manufacturing for this particular market and what this means for our customers and partners is lower cost, almost 100% yield rates, better quality, and more availability of photochromatic eye-wear across a broader spectrum of eye-wear products. Not only does our new process alleviate many of the associated risks of the currently used flow-coating method, but the new methodology also allows us to create photochromatic products that we would otherwise be unable to create utilizing the flow-coating method." stated Kerry Harris a former U.S. Marine Officer and Navy pilot who is the Director and Chief Technology Officer of Angel 7 Industries, LLC.

A7 currently produces it's state-of-the-art photochromatic eye-wear systems under the brand name "GHOST SHIELD" for military and sports applications, and is considering entering the ophthalmic market next year under it's Optical Division. Ghost Shield is a complete product philosophy with regards to photochromatic eye-wear and eye protection systems that not only utilizes the new manufacturing methodology, but also incorporates photochromatic properties that transition 35% faster than any other photochromatic product on the market.
